Bower, for twelve years a member of the Kansas City Board of Trade, died yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock at his home, 2126 North Fifth Street, Kansas City, Kas., after an illness of six weeks. He was 46 years old and leaves a widow and two children, Esther and Kenneth. Mr. Bower came to Kansas City twelve years ago from Delphos, Kas., where he was a banker. Since then he has conducted the Bower Grain-Commission Company, 516 Board of Trade Building.

Funeral services will be held at the home at 2:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. The burial will be in Mount Hope Cemetery.
