The Dupuys of Greenup County are descended from Bartholomew's eldest son Peter, who married Judith Lefevre. The fourth son of Peter and Judith Lefevre Dupuy was named Peter. He married Elizabeth Malone and their eldest son was named William. He served as captain in the Revolutionary War, moved from Pittsylvania County, Virginia, to land known as "The French Grant," near Wheelersburg, Ohio, and from there to Springville (South Portsmouth), Kentucky, where he died. His first wife was Elizabeth Fuqua and his second, Peggy Littlejohn.

The Greenup Dupuys are descended from William and Elizabeth Fuqua Dupuy. Their eldest son, Moses Fuqua Dupuy, was born in 1799 and died in 1889. In 1818, he married Phebe Stephenson. Albert Gallatin, the fourth son of Moses and Phebe Stephenson Dupuy, was born in 1829. In 1862 he married Ann B. Lee. They had six children, Agnes Mary, Samuel Edward, Rosswell, William, Ernest Richard and Bessie.
