has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Springfield
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said ~~John~~ ^{Anthony} Deardorff
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the third half of the north east fractional quarter of section six, in Township
fourteen North, of Range four West, in the district of lands offered for sale
at Springfield, Illinois, containing twenty acres more or less, which tract was
according to the official plan of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said ~~John~~ ^{Anthony} Deardorff.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said ~~John~~ ^{Anthony} Deardorff
~~his heirs~~ ^{John} Deardorff ~~his heirs~~ the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appur-
tenances, of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said ~~John~~ ^{Anthony} Deardorff
and ~~to his~~ ^{John} heirs and assigns forever.

affixed.
